RCRC Hosts Board of Directors Meeting in Inyo County

SACRAMENTO, CA – April 25, 2019 – Nearly 50 locally elected officials, county leaders, and staff will descend upon Inyo County next week as the Rural County Representatives of California ([RCRC](http://rcrcnet.org)) hosts its Board of Directors meeting at The Oasis at Death Valley. Inyo County Supervisor Matt Kingsley serves as the 2019 Chair of the 36-member county organization.

The two-day event commences Wednesday May 1st with a tour of Death Valley National Park, with stops at Zabriskie Point, Badwater, Harmony Borax Works, and the Furnace Creek Visitors Center. The event will conclude with the RCRC Board of Directors meeting at The Inn at Death Valley on Thursday May 2nd at 8:00 a.m.

“My role as Chair of RCRC often takes me to Sacramento and Washington, D.C. to advocate for California’s rural counties,” said Supervisor Kingsley. “This event allows Inyo County’s majestic beauty to be showcased with my rural colleagues, and for me to share our successes and challenges on a number of fronts.”
