## WEBINAR

The North State Drinking Water Solutions Network is an ad-hoc group convened by the Northern California Water Association as a forum for interested parties to share information and coordinate efforts related to ensuring that all communities in the Sacramento River Basin have access to safe drinking water.

Representatives from local government, water systems, nonprofit technical providers, landowners, and others interested in advancing drinking water solutions are all invited to participate.

The first meeting will be conducted via webinar and focus on sharing information regarding:

- Drinking water challenges in the Sacramento River Basin, including arsenic, nitrate, and hexavalent chromium.
- Updates from the State Water Board regarding new state funding and technical assistance opportunities, including the Safe & Affordable Drinking Water Fund and Administrator Policy.
- Existing non-profit technical assistance and training programs available to small water systems, schools, and others.
- Ongoing efforts by water suppliers to expand access to safe drinking water and the Sacramento Valley Water Quality Coalition's work to protect surface water and groundwater quality.
